Pattern for Knitted Knockers – Knit pattern	#sts
1 set of double pointed needles – size 4.5mm (if you knit loose – use	size 4.0mm). Soft, DK weight yarn that
is soft and washable (NOT WOOL). Marker (to mark needle 1)*, tape	stry needle.
Outer Piece	
CO 3 sts- knit rows I-cord – this will be knotted for the nipple. Leave about a 6" tail	3
Next Row – kfb every stitch	6
Divide on three needles – start knitting in the round	6 - 2 each needle
Round 1 – kfb, k1 (each needle	9 - 3 each needle
Next round – K to last stitch on each needle, m1, k1	12 - 4 each needle
A cup – repeat 18 times or amount equal 5" across	66 - 22 each needle
B cup – repeat 20 times 5 ½" diameter	72 - 24 each needle
C cup – repeat 24 times 6" diameter	84 - 28 each needle
D cup – repeat 26 times 6 ½" diameter	90 - 30 each needle
E cup – repeat 28 times 7" diameter	96 - 32 each needle
P 2 rounds	
Inner Piece	
Round 1 – K to last 2 sts, K2tog (each needle)	
Round 2 – ssk, k to last 2 sts, k2tog (each needle)	
Repeat 2 rounds until 12 sts total (4 each needle)	
Cut yarn (long tail) – thread tail through 12 sts. Do not tie off to allow	w for stuffing.
Knot I-cord very tightly and stitch down for small nipple.	
Fill with soft quality Fiberfil for pillows	- optional

**Abbreviations:** CO – cast on; M1 – make a stitch; kfb – knit front and back; ssk – slip, slip, knit

Knitted Knockers only take about 50 yards of yarn, so one ball of Patons Grace should produce a pair and at least part of a third Knocker. The most popular colour is nude and pastel colours. Don't have enough of one colour to finish off a knocker, feel free to the inner piece with a complimentary colour using the same type of yarn. Don't stress too much about the sizing- as long as each pair is the same size (same number of stitches). It is not necessary to stuff the knockers as the organisation will be happy to stuff them once they arrive. About 75% of the requests are for size B and C and the rest size A and D. These Knitted Knockers are beautifully contoured and hold up very well. Once you get past the first few rows, you will be find these are a fun, portable project that could take as little as 2 – 3 hours each. If you don't want to knit the nipple, just CO 3 sts and go on to the next row!
